

What is PC GAPS (The Preferred Communities supplemental)?

The PC GAPS program is designed to assist Ukrainian humanitarian parolees(UHP) with intake, assessment and referral to receive necessary benefits and services within 90 days of their enrollment in the program.

The program is designed to meet clients basic needs, address immediate concerns, and enable them to take important steps toward self-sufficiency quickly.

Who is funding PC GAPS?

PC GAPS program is funded by the U.S. Government's Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR).

How can CWS help?

CWS staff work with clients to identify barriers to self-sufficiency, set goals and provide guidance to help them overcome those barriers, and conduct monthly assessments to check for actual progress. This is not a financial assistance program, but it will promote financial stability by assisting with:

- Applying for social security cards, employment authorization documents, driver's licenses, public assistance, school enrollment, and other public services as needed
- Addressing physical and mental health needs, including referrals for medical and tuberculosis screenings
- Referrals to immigration legal services providers
- Referrals to other assistance programs, such as the PC Intensive Case Management (ICM) program and the Supplemental Security Income program, depending on your eligibility
- Receive other services as needed and appropriate.

Who is eligible for PC GAPS?

Certain Ukrainian individuals, or non-Ukrainian individuals who last habitually resided in Ukraine, who was paroled in period 2/24/2022-9/30/2024.
